GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entry deadline: must be postmarked by March 21, 2009. No entries accepted after April 1. Pay Pal accepted. See on-line entry.
- Payment and waiver not postmarked by March 21st will be assessed a \$20.00 late fee. \$25.00 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be provided.
- All team entries must be sent in by director with correct fee and a list of names, ages and birthdays. Include waivers from individual entry.
- Sheridan Recreation Center, contest directors are NOT responsible for accidents or lost items.
- 2010 NBTA rules and regulations will be in effect.
- No flash pictures allowed during competition. Video tape only your own twirler or group.
- Miss Majorette includes modeling (Circle-T in dress) with interview, X-strut and solo. Solo level determines category to enter. All other levels of pageant- contestant wears costume for modeling. Includes Solo and X (novice does basic).
- Miss Columbine Modeling- dress or costume with interview.
- When determining level to enter, remember all wins count regardless of organization. Any firsts (even in a pageant event) must be counted as a win at that level. Once a win at a higher level has occurred, a twirler may not go back down to a lower level regardless of # of wins. Uncontested wins count. Totals are as follows: Nov. 3 maximum, Beg. 5 maximum, Int. 8 maximum. Once maximum is reached, advancement must occur.
- Must be CO resident to enter Instate and pageant events. Non-CO residents may do visitor events and all Open events including Miss Columbine.

Half Time Show Twirl, Pom, Dance Line:

(Division by Average Age)

Kinder: 0-7.99

Primary: 8-10.99

Junior: 11-13.99

Time Limits:

Modeling 1:00 Max.

All Modeling is Circle-T pattern. Interview is not part of time. Miss Columbine is done in dress or costume, with interview.

Basic and Military are not timed, salute not required. Both are done in a square.

- Solo, Duet- Nov. :30-2:00, Beg. 1:30-2:00, Int. 1:50-2:10, Adv. 2:20-2:30
- X-Strut- Nov. :30-2:00 All others 1:30-2:00
- 2-Baton- Nov.:30-2:00 All others 1:30-2:00
- 3-Baton- :03-2:00
- Flag, Hoop, Rifle- 1:30-2:00
- Ribbon (non-sanctioned)- 1:00-2:00
- Rhythmic Twirl- 2:00-2:30
- Teams, Trios- 2:00-3:00
- Show Twirl, 1:30-2:30
- Pom Solo, 1:30 max
