From I-25: Exit at Harmony Road in Fort Collins. Use exit # 265. Go west for about four miles. Turn left on Lemay. Go south for one block. Turn right at the first street (not business entrances). There is a light at that intersection. The Church is on your left. Go past it and turn into the entrance on your left. You will go around to the back (south) side of the building.

Directions to hotel: Exit from I-25 at the Harmony Exit. Go WEST for about 2 miles. Hotel will be on your left. Numerous restaurants are located close to the hotel on Harmony.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entry deadline: must be postmarked by September 13, 2010.
- Payments and entries postmarked between Sept. 14 and Sept. 22 will be assessed a \$20.00 late fee. No entries accepted after Sept. 22.
- No refunds will be provided.
- All team entries must be sent in by director with correct fee and a list of names, ages and birthdays. Include waivers from individual entry.
- Evangelical Covenant Church, contest directors are NOT responsible for accidents or lost items.
- 2010 NBTA rules & regulations will used.
- No flash pictures allowed during competition. Video tape only your own twirler or group.
- Concession stand will be available with breakfast and lunch items.
- Miss Fall Festival includes modeling (Circle-T in twirling costume) with interview, X-strut or USTA Strut and solo. (Novice does Basic instead of X-Strut.) Solo level determines category to enter.
- Fall Sportswear modeling has no interview. Casual sportswear is acceptable attire.
- When determining level to enter, remember all wins count regardless of organization. Any firsts (even in a pageant event) must be counted as a win at that level. Once a win at a higher level has occurred, a twirler may not go back down to a lower level regardless of # of wins. Uncontested NBTA wins count. Totals are as follows: Nov. 3 maximum, Beg. 5 maximum, Int. 8 maximum. Once maximum is reached, advancement must occur.
- Each contestant entering individual events will receive a program at the door contest day.

Evangelical Covenant Gym and grounds is a total No-Smoking environment. No smoking is permitted anywhere in the building or on the grounds. Smoking must be limited to smokers' vehicles with cigarette butts placed in car ashtrays

All Modeling is Circle-T pattern, in twirling costume.

Interview is not part of time. Fall Sportswear Modeling is done in sportswear or other casual outfit, no interview.

Basic and Military are not timed, salute not required. Both are done in a square.

- Solo, Duet- Nov. :30-2:00, Beg. 1:30-2:00, Int. 1:50-2:10, Adv. 2:20-2:30
- X-Strut- Nov. :30-2:00 All others 1:30-2:00
- 2-Baton, Nov.:30-2:00 All others 1:30-2:00
- 3-Baton, Flag, Hoop, Rifle- 1:30-2:00
- Ribbon (non-sanctioned)- 1:00-2:00
- Rhythmic Twirl, Teams, Trios- 2:00-3:00
- Show Twirl, 1:30-2:30
